National Small Boat Sailing Course

The National Small Boat Sailing course will progressively teach you how to sail dinghies and catamarans using qualified Australian Sailing instructors. These courses will provide a safe and enjoyable introduction to small boat sailing and are held over 6 weeks (weather permitting). It is an introduction to fundamental boat handling skills and essential water safety knowledge.

COURSE - "START SAILING 1" and "START SAILING 2"

- * START SAILING 1 - Beginners course - Learn - Prepare and Plan, Rigging, Ropework, Sailing Techniques and Manoeuvres, Rescue procedures and drills, Launching and recovery, Sailing Theory and background, Winds, tides and currents.
- * START SAILING 1 & 2 - As Above and also care of equipment, coming alongside to a fixed anchored structure, port/starboard windward/leeward, keeping to channels, overtaking and reading tides, launching and recovery, lifting, trolleys, avoiding collisions and power/ sail right of way and towing.
- * **COURSE - "BETTER SAILING" - by appointment only**

Start Sailing 1 & 2
\$350 per course
(for Adults and children over 10)

For those with sailing experience - Learn - Trapeze harness selection, rigging and ropework, Boat speed control, sailing downwind, sailing backwards, getting out of irons, roll tacking and gybing, spinnaker handling, boat handling, launching and recovery skills, navigation marker bouys, first aid injury awareness, weather information, lifts and knocks, tide flows sea and land breezes.
